Ladywell Metrolink stop **Phase 1**

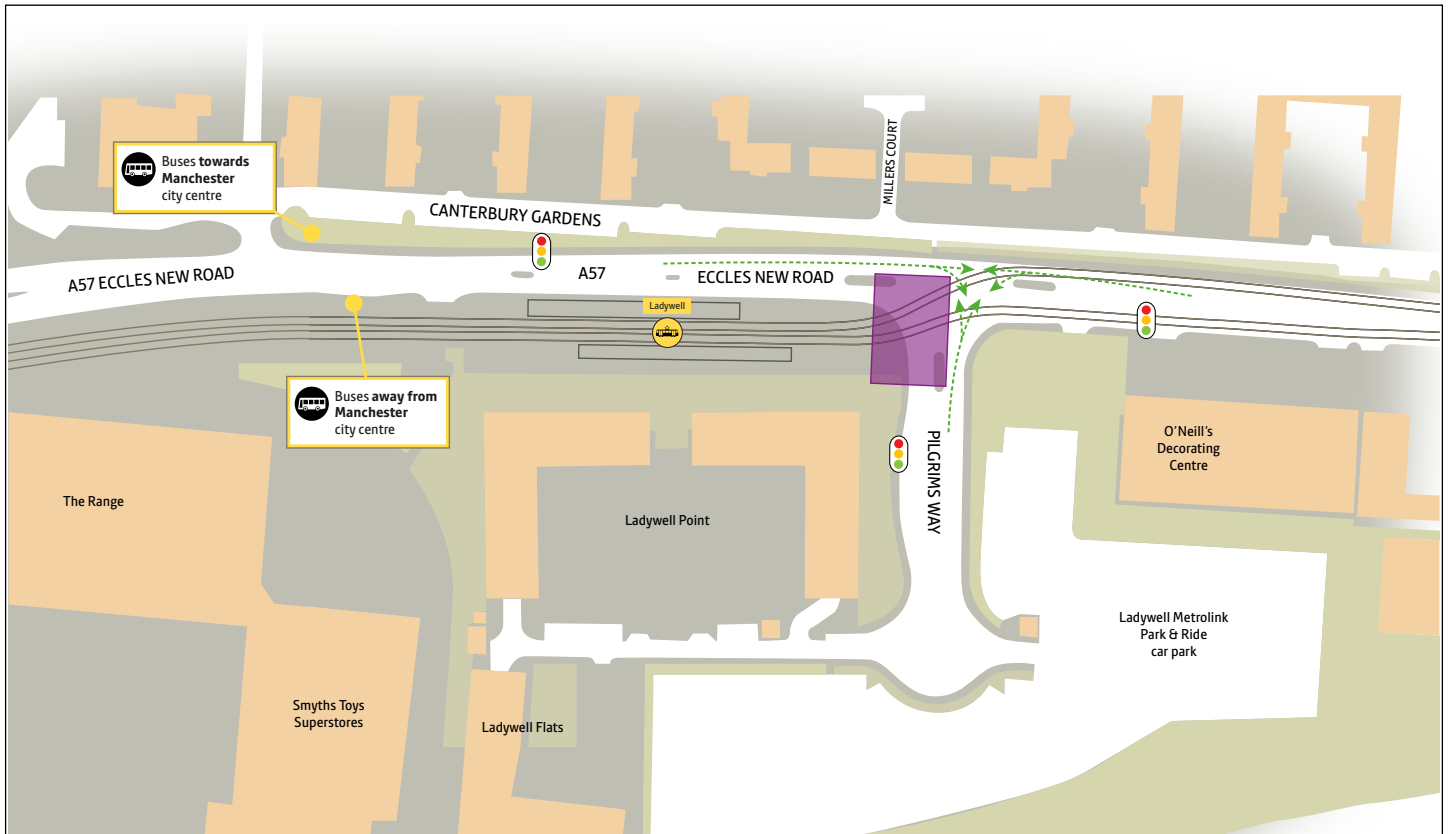
A major track replacement programme will see the Eccles via MediaCityUK Metrolink line temporarily close from Sunday 26 June. Transport for Greater Manchester has worked with Metrolink's operator and maintainer, MRDL, to time the essential upgrades to coincide with final works at St Peter's Square stop, when fewer people will be travelling due to the summer holiday period.






Eccles line services are expected to resume between Deansgate-Castlefield and MediaCityUK in early August, with the full line reopening at the end of August.

On-highway works will take place at Ladywell Metrolink stop, at the junction of Eccles New Road and Pilgrims Way, from **Monday 27 June for approximately 15 days**. While no lane or road closures are required for these works, temporary traffic lights will be in place to allow for safe working and management of traffic on the highway.

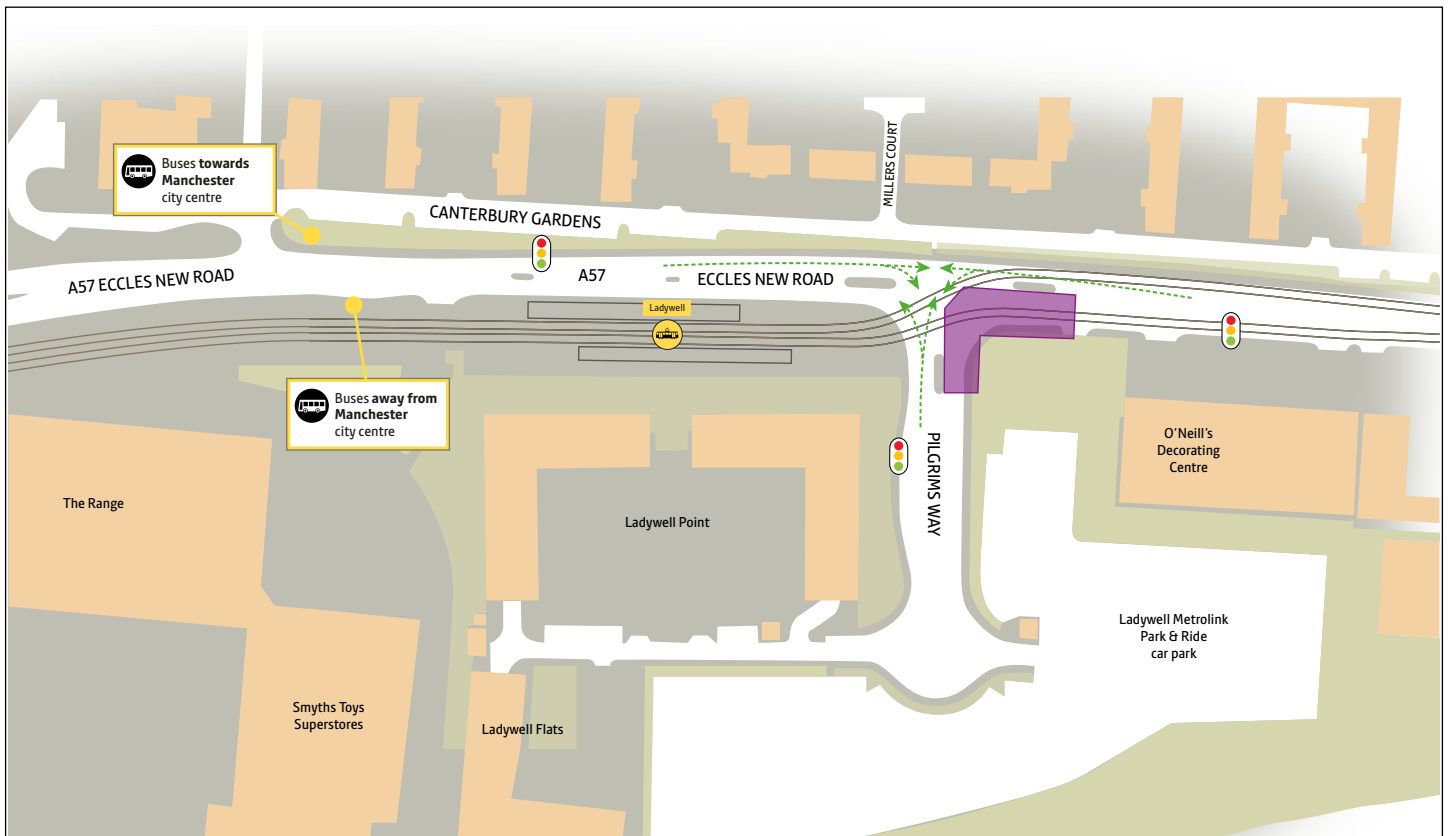

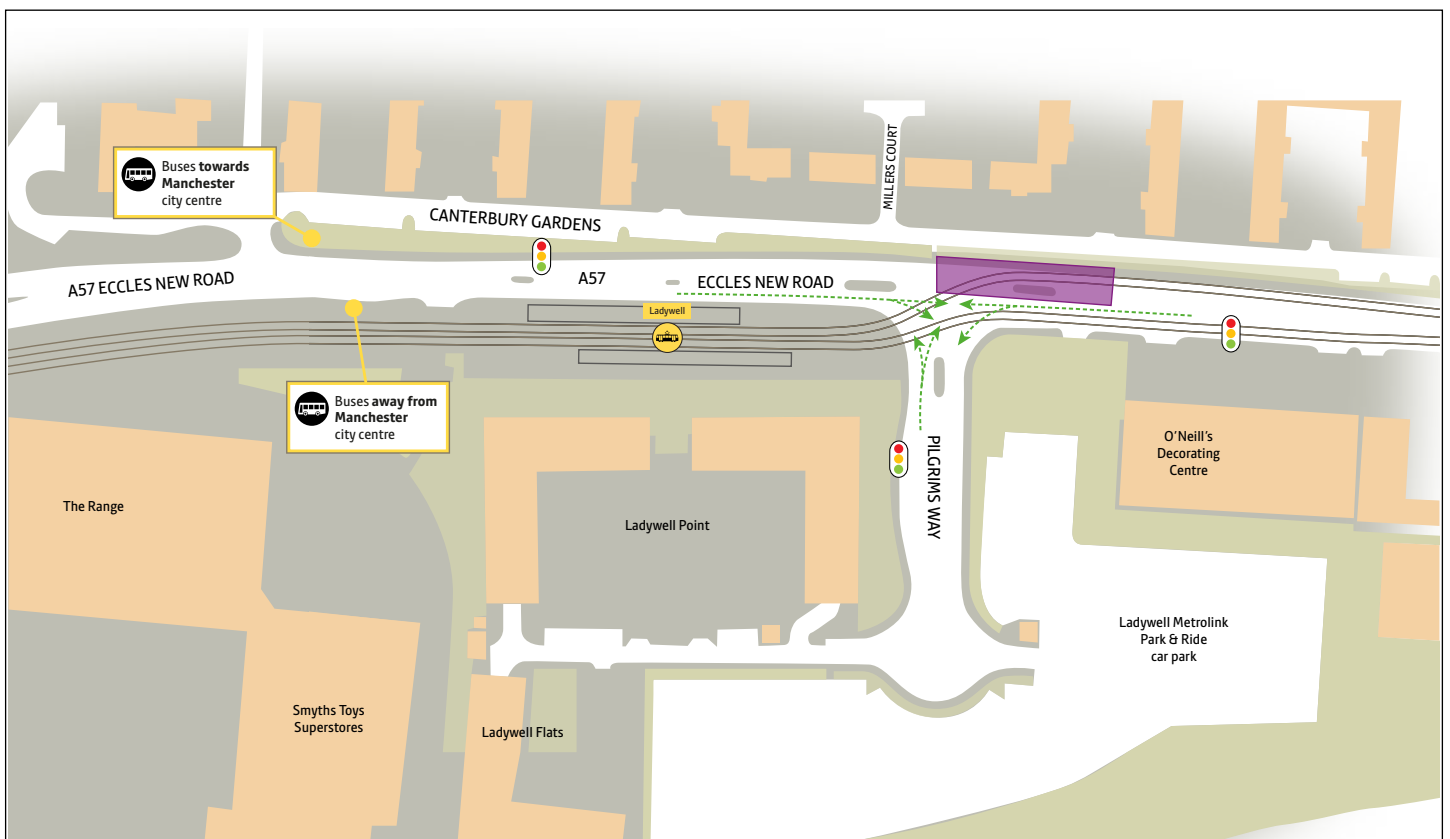
