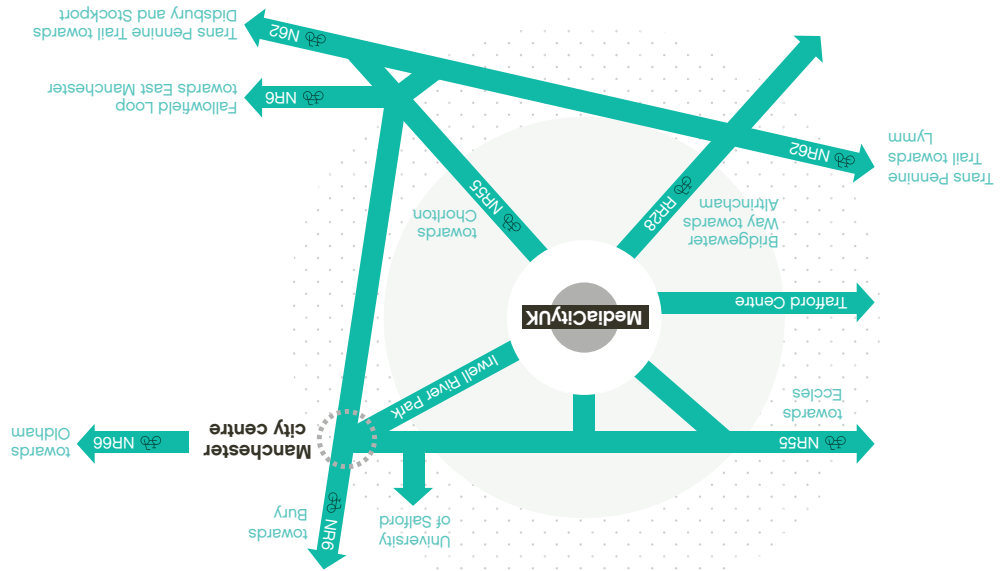


How to find me — Planning your journey

MediaCityUK is easy to reach by bike or on foot using a network of direct, safe and attractive cycling and walking routes. Located along the Irwell River Park, many routes utilise the Manchester Ship Canal, the River Irwell and the Bridgewater Canal to provide safe traffic-free journeys to MediaCityUK.



Have you tried?

Route 55

- National Cycle Network Route 55 runs through the heart of MediaCityUK to Salford, Chorlton and South Manchester. The route also connects to other NCN routes including:
- Route 6 to the north through Salford and south along the Fallsfield Loop through Chorlton; Route 62 providing off-road links to the south along the Mersey Valley
 - Regional Route 28 along the Bridgewater Canal towards Sale and Altrincham

Irwell River Park

A dedicated cycle and pedestrian route from MediaCityUK to the Manchester City Centre along the banks of the Manchester Ship Canal and River Irwell.

Broadway / Coronet Way

A largely traffic-free route heading west towards Eccles.

Cross Lane / The Quays

A direct cycle link to University of Salford (main campus) and Salford Crescent Rail Station.

Parking your cycle

Convenient, secure cycle parking is provided across MediaCityUK for the benefit of employees, visitors and residents. We offer dedicated Sheffield loop cycle parking adjacent to most buildings and the MediaCityUK Cycle Hub.

When leaving your bike at MediaCityUK, please ensure you take all of the removable items, such as lights, computer and panniers, with you and lock your bike securely.

The MediaCityUK Cycle Hub is our purpose-built secure cycle parking facility located adjacent to The Greenhouse and Orange, providing:

- 300 secure covered cycle parking spaces
- CCTV/swipe card entry
- Male and female showers, toilets and changing facilities
- Heated locker room
- Cycle maintenance and repair service
- Easy access to cycling information, including journey planning and cycle to work rides.

Code of Conduct

— MediaCityUK welcomes considerate cyclists and pedestrians who follow the MediaCityUK Code of Conduct

Be aware

MediaCityUK is a mixed-use environment. Please be aware of other cyclists and pedestrians, particularly along the bridges and in the MediaCityUK Piazza. Cyclists are asked to use the roads, where provided, and to adhere to the Highway Code. Pedestrians should use the footpaths provided.

Be careful

Cyclists and pedestrians should be particularly careful at junctions, bends, entrances/exits onto the bridges, across

the MediaCityUK Piazza and Lowry Plaza, along the Metrolink line and at any other 'blind spot' where other users, including vehicles and motorcycles, could appear in front of you without warning.

Be seen and heard

Cyclists are asked to carry lights and a bell and to use them. However, please don't assume that other people can see or hear you – remember that there are people that are hard of hearing or visually impaired. Pedestrians should ensure that they are aware of approaching cyclists and vehicles.

Slow down

The shared paths and public spaces are for sharing, not speeding. Cyclists should slow down on their approach to MediaCityUK

and maintain a slow speed whilst cycling through the area. Cyclists are advised to dismount on the bridges.

Park right

Cyclists should park their bicycles at the dedicated 'Sheffield' stands located throughout MediaCityUK or at the MediaCityUK Cycle Hub. We undertake regular audits of the bicycle parking facilities and will identify and remove any bicycles that have either been parked outside these dedicated areas or abandoned for more than 7 days. We will also remove any bicycles that are not secured.

Lock it

Please ensure that you use a lock to park your bike and postcode your bicycle. Cycle security advice and the purchase of locks is available

at the regular INTERACT events, at the Permit Office, via security@mediacityuk.co.uk or by calling 0161 855 6400. Greater Manchester Police advise that locks should have a 'Sold Secure' rating and that bikes are registered on immobilise.com.

Be safe

When leaving your bike at MediaCityUK, please ensure you take all of the removable items, such as lights, computer and panniers, with you and lock your bike securely. If you leave your panniers on your bike then we reserve the right to search these in the interests of security. We cannot be held responsible for the theft of your bike or the loss of any items taken from it.
